MATERIALS:

2-3 graphite pencils (HB, 2B, 4B, or 6B)

- Optional 2-3 charcoal pencils (HB, 2B, 4B, or 6B)
- 1 package vine charcoal, soft (medium thickness)
- 1 compressed charcoal, blackest (some are sold individually, like the Pitt pressed charcoal stick, and some brands come in 3 pack or larger, like Heritage Arts Char-Cole soft pastel, or Alphacolor Char-Kole)
- 1 Conté crayon, white (Conté à Paris brand, or in General's brand 'compressed charcoal')
- 1 Conté crayon, black (Conté à Paris brand, or in General's brand 'compressed charcoal')
- 1 white plastic eraser (Mars Staedtler, Factis, or other brand)
- 1 kneadable eraser
- 12-18 inch ruler
- 1 sketchbook standard drawing paper (5 x 7 inches and larger is fine)
- 1 newsprint drawing pad, 18" x 24", 50-100 sheets
- Drawing pad board, 23" x 26" or larger ("built-in" clips are helpful as board bands often break; usually made of masonite)
- Optional Chamois cloth (cheapest at auto parts store)
